**VI. Discuss Site Visitations**

Megan met with the Hays County Child Protective Board, which is requesting \$20,000 for supplies and clothing for children and their families that are in need in emergency situations. The main focus for this board is to provide and promote a safe environment for all Hays County children that are abused and neglected. Board is strictly volunteered based, no funding will be used salaries.

Devin met with Jennifer Vogel with the SMCISD. She is asking \$15,000 for the Age Parenting program, “Follow up and Recovery Program.” This program enables school-age parents to graduate and to continue their educational pursuits. Funding requested is to provide a partial salary for the Follow-Up and Recovery Specialist.

Next, Tom met with Combined Community Action regarding the “Meals on Wheels” Program. This program provides meals to seniors 60 years of age and older. Monday through Friday, meals are provided at three different locations throughout San Marcos served and for pickup.

This agency also provides nutritious meals home delivered for those individuals who are homebound. The agency is requesting \$15,000 to purchase meals and no funding will go towards salaries.

Eleanor discussed her visit with the Hays-Caldwell Women's Center in which they are requesting \$70,000 for three programs; Family Violence, Sexual Assault & Abuse and Roxanne's House. All three of these prevention programs provide a 24-7 hotline service for anyone who needs assistance. These programs provide shelter for abused victims, counseling, support groups, and other variety of services. Funds being requested are to meet program costs, not salaries.


