

## Process and Results – Framework and Top 10 Priorities

### Purpose:

- ❖ To identify major categories and priorities
- ❖ To begin to frame the implementation plan

### Process:

- ❖ The Committee members were provided with a formatted document to insert 10 mini-goals they feel will best contribute to a 90% live outcome rate
  - They were to review all committee work to date, plus samples of other plans
  - They were to work in pairs (the 2 people representing each organization)
  - Their framework could include up to 10 mini-goals
  - Under each mini-goal, they were to include up to 5 objectives or strategies to support it.
- ❖ The framework documents submitted by the committee members were compiled into a single document, sorting by all entries for mini-goal 1, then mini-goal 2, and so on
- ❖ Recurring mini-goals and words were identified
- ❖ At the Pawsitive Outcomes IPC meeting on March 20, 2019, committee members viewed a web presentation by Dr. Greenberg of Target Zero/Maddie's Fund
- ❖ Next, the committee members began working on the Top 10 assignment
  - Using the information and data they learned from the presentation, along with all committee work done to this point (especially the framework summary), each member pair was asked to develop a top 10 list by priority
- ❖ Priorities #1-10 were compiled in time for the first public input session on March 21<sup>st</sup>
