

PUBLIC NOTICE-BUDGET HEARING

All citizens are invited to attend and participate with both written and/or oral comments and/or questions concerning the entire 2008-2009 Budget in a public hearing to be held by the City Council of the City of San Marcos, Texas, on Tuesday, August 19, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 630 E. Hopkins Street, San Marcos, Texas, including all funds in the following categories: (1) General Fund; (2) Debt Service Fund; (3) Hotel Occupancy Tax Fund; (4) Municipal Court Technology Fund; (5) Municipal Court Security Fee Fund; (6) Seized Assets Fund; (7) Community Development Block Grant Program Fund; (8) W.I.C. Program Fund; (9) Cemetery Operations Fund; (10) Cemetery Perpetual Care Fund; (11) Water/Wastewater Utility Fund; (12) Drainage Utility Fund; (13) Electric Utility Fund; (14) Municipal Airport Fund; and (15) Waste Collection Utility Fund. Hopkins Street, Monday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; and Sundays from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (except holidays).
