I have read, understand, and agree to the following program guidelines:

- I am a City of San Marcos single-family residential water customer with an account in good standing.
- The rain barrel will be installed at the address above and will remain at this address for a minimum of two years or for the lifetime of the product.
- The rain barrel is a new, finished rain barrel sold solely for the purpose of collecting rain water.
- The rain water will be used for non-potable, outdoor uses only. Rain barrel and associated piping/hoses should be clearly marked as “non-potable water”.
- The rain barrel is securely covered and/or screened to restrict access by children, pets, rodents and insects.
- The rain barrel is ultraviolet resistant to restrict algae growth. Non-uv resistant barrels (white or light colors) must be painted or enclosed.
- A dated and itemized sales receipt must be provided with this application. Completed application must be received within 30 days of purchase date.
- Prior to issuance of a rebate check, a site inspection may be conducted to verify installation. The rain barrel must be installed and functional at the time of the inspection.
- Rebates are offered on a first come/first serve basis, and are subject to availability of funds.
- Rebate will include cost of the rain barrel only, in the amount of 50% of the purchase price up to a maximum of \$50.
- I understand that the City of San Marcos does not guarantee materials, workmanship, performance, durability or safety of rebated products.
